



MUSEUM CONDUCT

To make your experience as positive as possible, we ask that you, your students, and your chaperones follow some rules of conduct while your group is at the Anchorage Museum. Just remember to LEARN:

- **Listen:** Follow all instructions provided by museum staff and refrain from side conversations or cell phone use during your visit.
- **Engage:** Actively participate in the learning experience and interact with the exhibitions.
- **Attend:** Keep track of assigned students and adhere to scheduled times for programs, lunch, and free-choice exploration. All students must be supervised at all times.
- **Respect:** Show respect for the museum's exhibits and staff and be a good model of behavior for students. Deal with behavioral issues.
- **No-nos:** Please remind students the museum doesn't allow running, yelling, or chewing gum. Food and drink are not allowed in galleries. Some objects are touchable, some are not: Please consult gallery signage.
