Administrative/Biographical History:

"Brown & Hawkins [was] a general store in Seward, Alaska. It was founded in 1904 to serve the town and those constructing of the Alaska Central Railroad." The business was founded by Charles E. Brown of Montreal, Quebec, Canada, and T.W. Hawkins of Roanoke, Virginia, who met each other in Nome during the Gold Rush. The store was owned by the Hawkins family until 2013, when it went out of business. The building still exists and is on the National Register of Historic Places.<sup>1</sup>

Scope and Content Description:

This collection consists of one 20"x27" 12-page calendar for the year 1963, titled "Brown & Hawkins: celebrating 60 years of service to Seward, 1903-1963." Each page contains the same image and "thumb nail historical sketch," as well as each month's calendar and weather forecasts. The calendar was published to celebrate the store's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
