The University of Alaska Fairbanks holds a collection of 22 Sheelor panoramas (USUAFV6-41) including images of Ketchikan, Wrangell, Juneau, Haines, Skagway, Valdez, Cordova, Latouche, Seward, Anchorage, Saint Michael, Nulato, and Fairbanks, as well as Mount Foraker/Mount McKinley, reindeer, glaciers, Dawson City in Yukon Territory, and hydraulic mines of the Yukon Gold Company.

One black-and-white panoramic photograph measuring 60.5" x 12" of Fairbanks, Alaska, in October 1915, showing the Chena River waterfront and bridge.
