Images 1-6 are of a dance troupe at a folklore concert held December 2-3, 1990, in Magadan, Russia. Images 7-23 depict the social life and customs of Native peoples, possibly the Evenki and Chukchi, probably in Magadan or Chukotka. An accompanying news clipping is dated October 1, 1989.
