Administrative/Biographical History:

June and Ben Johns moved to Alaska in 1945 and settled in a cabin at Skipper Lake near the Jonesville Mine. As a member of the Reserve Corps, Ben had been sent by the U.S. Military to work at the mine as fire boss. June noted that, "There were only about 10 women at the mine," and that "Women were respected there." For a brief time, Ben also worked for the Houston Coal Mine before it fell through around 1949.

During the 1950s, the Johns lived in the Spenard area of Anchorage and eventually left Alaska in 1971. Not much else was known about the Johns when this Finding Aid was written.

Scope and Content Description: This collection contains 206 photographic prints, mostly black and white. The majority of the images were captured by June and primarily depict everyday life during the Johns' time at Jonesville. Also included are photos of the Matanuska Valley area, glaciers, heavy snowfall in Whittier, buildings and events around Anchorage, and highway scenery.

Arrangement: Collection arranged by previous archivist.
