



2019-2020 Academic Year Education Internship Opportunity

WHEN: Two semesters, August 2019- May 2020, start and end dates are flexible.
Work schedule will be Monday – Friday, 8-10 hrs/week
Morning availability on at least two days a week (9-1) is required.

WHERE: Anchorage Museum, in Anchorage, Alaska.

WHAT: The Anchorage Museum is seeking enthusiastic applicants for a 2019-2020 academic year Education Internship.

The cohort of three interns will work directly with museum educators to develop and provide school group experiences for K-12 audiences. As well, interns will work with museum staff to research and create teaching and learning materials. Interns will be trained in teaching methodologies and given extensive experience in program delivery. Interns will also receive experience in curriculum development and creating lessons for various age ranges. The intern will additionally receive an introduction to informal educational pedagogies and approaches. The position includes mentorship in program development, public speaking, time management strategies, and evaluation of informal learning environments. No previous teaching experience is necessary, but a strong interest in teaching is preferred.

The internship position can be completed for college credit with faculty sponsorship. Housing benefits and transportation are not provided.

WHO: Applicants must be at least 18, computer literate, and may be a current student or a recent graduate in Art, History, Anthropology, Native Studies, Library and Information Science, Museum Studies, Education, Engineering, Science, or related field.
