



## **2019 Exhibitions & Engagement Internship Opportunity**

The Anchorage Museum connects people, expands perspectives, and encourages global dialog about the North and its distinct environment. Exploring the intersection of art, history and science, the Anchorage Museum shares multiple perspectives and experiences that tell a greater story. We welcome diverse perspectives and recognize all are enriched when a diversity of voices, viewpoints, and skills are included and engaged in the work we do.

**WHEN:** Approximately 10 weeks, September 23 – December 6, 2019. Start and end dates are flexible. The work schedule will be approximately 15 hours per week, Monday – Friday, during regular business hours but can be flexible depending on the student’s class schedule.

**WHERE:** At the Anchorage Museum in beautiful downtown Anchorage, Alaska.

**WHAT:** The Anchorage Museum is seeking applicants for the Exhibitions and Engagement Internship for the 2019 Fall semester. Opportunities and training may include researching and developing programs, educational, and outreach materials with a focus on upcoming exhibitions. Interns will assist with program delivery and tours, create resources, and provide overall support to curatorial content and educational programming, including but not limited to public programs and classes for the public. Interns may also assist with exhibition logistics, including but not limited to hands-on exhibit research and development.

The incumbent will receive a stipend of \$2,500. Housing, benefits and transportation to the intern site are not provided.

**WHO:** Applicants must be at least 18, proficient in Microsoft Office (specifically Word, Excel, and Outlook), and should be a current student or a recent graduate in museum studies, art, history or related field. Previous experience with curation, curriculum or program development is preferred, but not required.
