Walter Blue was born in Seward on March 1, 1909. He taught history at the Alaska Senior College in Anchorage and served as Command Historian for the U.S. Army in the 1970s. He died on August 30, 1990.

**Scope and Content Description:**

The collection contains 19 images including Blue family photographs circa 1910-1949, commercial postcards circa 1910-1930s, and official USARAL photographs circa 1960s, all collected by Walter Blue. Also included is a loose-leaf notebook containing typescript unit movements for United States Army units serving in Alaska in the period 1942-1963.
