- .2 – [man wearing hat, zippered jacket, wool socks, and lace-up boots sitting on bench outside wooden building next to pile of firewood; at AFN 2015, man tentatively identified as a Aqpayuk Hensley]
- .3 – [street scene, gravel road along shoreline with ocean at left and walled tents at right, three men in military uniform on road in distance]
- .4 – [digital print, still frame from motion picture. Young boy standing on beach. At AFN 2018, tentatively identified as John “Budoo” Gallahorn]
