


# **ENTER THE MUSEUM**

I MAY HAVE TO STAND IN LINE AND WAIT MY TURN.


## PHOTOS MAY BE TAKEN


## SENSORY SENSITIVITY RESOURCES






#### SOME OBJECTS ARE FOR LOOKING

IF I NEED TO **USE THE BATHROOM**, I WILL LOOK FOR A BATHROOM SIGN OR ASK MUSEUM STAFF.

# IF I GET HUNGRY





I CAN EAT OR DRINK IN THE ATRIUM. I WILL THROW MY TRASH AWAY WHEN I AM DONE. THIS IS THE ONLY PLACE IN THE MUSEUM THAT I CAN EAT FOOD I BROUGHT.

# THE MUSEUM OPENS TO THE PUBLIC





WHEN THE MUSEUM OPENS AT NOON, MORE PEOPLE WILL BE IN THE BUILDING. AFTER NOON, I CAN GO INTO OTHER ROOMS WITH MY ADULT. I CAN ALSO BUY FOOD FROM THE MUSE COFFEE STAND AND EAT IT IN THE ATRIUM.
