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Materials

- Scissors
- Yarn
- Cardboard
- Embroidery floss (optional)

Step 1: Make Loom Tool and Trim Guide

To create the loom tool and trim guide you will need a piece of cardboard no bigger than 8" by 11".




1. **Cut a piece of an rectangle shape of cardboard cutting a notch on one side, similar to the beige loom tool seen here.**



2. **Cut a circle out of the cardboard for the trim guide.**

Step 2: Wrap Yarn Around Loom Tool


Once you select the desired yarn color start wrapping the yarn around the loom tool you created out of the cardboard. After creating the first wrap around the loom too tie your yarn off to itself to hold the yarn in place.



1.
Wind the yarn around the loom tool starting from the middle of the slot.



3.
Wrap the yarn around the loom tool for about 120-160 times. Make sure your winding is taut but not too tight.



2.
Keep a small space at the end uncovered to use it later to tie the yarn.



4.
Once you finish wrapping, cut the yarn.

Step 3: Remove Pom-Pom from Loom Tool


Once you have finished wrapping the yarn, use an additional piece of yarn or string to secure the wrappings and then cut the wrappings.



1.
Cut a small piece of yarn or embroidery floss (about 17-20 inch).



3.
Make a knot in the middle of the yarn then flip your tool and make another tight knot in the other side.



2.
Slide the piece of yarn in the uncovered space.



4.
Once you tie the middle, cut the wrapped yarn from both edges.

Step 4: Trimming the Pom-Pom

Use the trim guide to put the finishing touches on your pom-pom.
