# COLAB CARDSTOCK ROSES

---

## Materials


- Cardstock in assorted colors
- Floral stem wire
- Hot glue
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pliers (optional)



**1.**  
Cut a square of cardstock  
6 inches x 6 inches



**4.**  
Cut a wavy line  
alongside the outer  
edge of the spiral.



**2.**  
Use scissors to cut off corners  
and shape the square into a  
circular shape.




**5.**  
Roll the flower tightly  
starting from the outside  
and aligning the smooth  
edge of the spiral as you  
go.



**3.**  
Cut the circle  
into a spiral.



**6.**  
Once you reach the  
center, let go of the  
spiral and allow it to  
grow. Adjust the spiral  
as needed to shape it  
into a flower.



**7.**  
Glue the spiraled petals onto the center of the spiral.



**10.**  
Glue the stem onto the bottom of the flower with hot glue. Allow to dry.



**8.**  
Ensure the center spirals are all glued securely onto the center of the spiral. Allow to dry.



**11.**  
The finished flower should look something like this.



**9.**  
Bend floral stem into a circular shape on the top end. You may wish to use pliers to assist in the bending.



**12.**  
Create a varied bouquet using different size squares and colors of cardstock.
