
# **COLAB PAPER QUILLING**

#### Materials

- Paper strips in assorted colors
- Quilling tool or toothpick
- Glue
- Cardstock
- Tweezers (optional)

**Note:** Try substituting similar materials in place of any items you do not have on hand.

# PAPER QUILILNG TEMPLATES



#### MAKING A PAPER QUILLED CARD

Before starting, decide on a design. Consult the template page for design ideas or create your own.



1. Fold a piece of cardstock in half



Create the paper quilled shapes you need for your design.



Lay out your design how you want it to look.



Put glue on the back side of your quilled shapes.



5.
Gently press the paper quilled shapes in place and hold until they dry a bit. Tweezers are sometimes helpful for this step.



Add any writing or additional elements to your design. Give it to a friend or loved one.

#### PAPER COIL



1.
Slide your strip of paper into the notch on the quilling tool. If using a toothpick, simply wrap tightly around the toothpick.



2. Tightly wrap the entire paper strip around the quilling tool.



3.
Remove the paper from the quilling tool. Set on the table and allow it to grow to the desired size.



Put a dot of glue on the outer end of the paper and glue it down



5. Pinch one side of the paper spiral.



Coils can be loose or tight or pinched into many other shapes, as demonstrated on the next few pages.

#### **TEARDROP SHAPE**



1.
Slide your strip of paper into the notch on the quilling tool. If using a toothpick, simply wrap tightly around the toothpick.



2. Tightly wrap the entire paper strip around the quilling tool.



3.
Remove the paper from the quilling tool. Set on the table and allow it to grow to the desired size.



4.
Put a dot of glue on the outer end of the paper and glue it down



Pinch one side of the paper spiral.



Your finished teardrop shape should look something like this.

### **EYE SHAPE**



1.
Slide your strip of paper into the notch on the quilling tool.
Tightly wrap the paper strip around the quilling tool.



2.
Remove the paper from the quilling tool.
Set it on the table and allow it to grow to the desired size.



3.
Put a dot of glue on the outer end of the paper and glue it down.



4. Pinch both sides of the paper spiral.



Your finished eye shape should look something like this.

#### **LEAF SHAPE**



1.
Slide your strip of paper into the notch on the quilling tool.
Tightly wrap the paper strip around the quilling tool.



2.
Remove the paper from the quilling tool.
Set it on the table and allow it to grow to the desired size.



3.
Put a dot of glue on the outer end of the paper and glue it down.



4. Grab both sides of the spiral.



Manipulate the spiral into the desired shape and pinch.



Your finished leaf shape should look something like this.

### **HEART SHAPE**



1. Fold your paper strip in half.



Your finished heart should look something like this.




2. Put one side of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch and tightly wrap inside until you reach the center fold.



3.
Put the other end of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch.
Tightly wrap along the inside until you reach the center fold.


## **V SHAPE**



Fold your paper strip in half.



Your finished V should look something like this.



2.
Put one side of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch and tightly wrap outwards towards the center fold.



3.
Put the other end of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch.
Tightly wrap outwards towards the center fold.

#### **SCROLL SHAPE**




1.
Put one side of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch and tightly wrap inside until you reach the center of the strip.



Your finished scroll should look something like this.



2. You should have one side rolled into a coil and one side left straight.



3.
Put the other end of the paper strip into the quilling tool's notch.
Tightly wrap in the oposite direction to create an "S" shape.
Wrap towards the center.

#### **BOARDER SHAPES**



1. Pick the boarder buddy shape or choose an object that is the shape you wish to create.



2.
Hold the end of your paper strip beside the object. Practice wrapping it around the object.



Put a dot of glue on the end of the strip.



4.
Wrap your paper
tightly around the
object. Put a dot of
glue on the far end of
the strip.



5.
Glue the end of your paper strip down to the boarder of paper. Allow it to dry completely.



Once dry, gently remove your boarder shape from the object. You may need to pinch corners slightly to shape them.
