Marion Taylor, resident of Anchorage, had a niece who found the collection in an abandoned cabin in the Matanuska Valley. The original owner is unknown.

The Matanuska Valley Collection contains 35 photographs and 13 negatives. The photographs are primarily of Palmer and the buildings around town, including the civic center, post office, railroad station, community hall, various churches and the Matanuska Valley Lodge. Other subjects include the miscellaneous people, the Jonesville Mine, the Sandvik farm, and Alaskan towns, such as Anchorage, Juneau, Yakutat, and Ketchikan.

This collection was donated to the Anchorage Museum by Marian Taylor in 1975.
