Administrative/Biographical History:

Saradell Carolyn Ard was born March 22, 1920, in Macon, Georgia, to Lillian Garrett Ard and John Ard. She grew up in Georgia and Florida and studied silver-smithing at Crafts Student League, New York City, and painting at the University of California, Berkeley, and the Arts Student League, New York City. She received her B.A. in art and speech from Asbury College, Wilmore, Kentucky, in 1942 and her M.A. in speech from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, the following year.

Ard taught art and speech at Asbury College from 1942 to 1947 and then moved to Wheaton College in Wheaton, Illinois, where she became an assistant professor of art and speech from 1947 to 1952. From 1954 to 1962 Ard worked as a civilian director for the U.S. Army Arts and Crafts Program at Fort Jay in New York, and in Europe from 1956 to 1962. Work with the Army brought her to Whittier, Alaska, and she moved to Alaska permanently in 1962. In Anchorage she taught art and speech at Alaska Methodist University (AMU) and was promoted to professor of art and speech in 1970 when she earned her Doctorate of Education in art from Columbia University Teachers College, New York. She taught at AMU until 1973 when she moved to the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) as a professor of art. There she

became Chairman of the Humanities Division 1974 to 1977 and acting dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, 1976 to 1977. When Ard retired from UAA in 1985 she was named *professor emerita*.

Starting late in the 1960s and throughout her teaching career and retirement, Ard collected and compiled information and images related to Eskimo/Inuit art of Alaska, Canada, Greenland, and Siberia. She traveled extensively to study prehistoric, historic, and contemporary Eskimo/Inuit art for a book she hoped to write which, at various times, was titled *Eskimo Art: A Circumpolar History*, *Eskimo Art of the Arctic* and *Inuit Art around the Arctic*. Although she had a contract with Harry Abrams, Inc. of New York to publish the book in 1982, personal and professional demands, over the years, prevented her from completing the project.

Ard was considered by some peers as an outstanding visual artist and pioneered teaching abstract painting in her classes at AMU and UAA. Her work is in the permanent collections of UAA and the Anchorage Museum.

In Anchorage, Ard was considered a leader in the arts scene as she helped establish the Institute of Alaska Native Arts, was a founding member of the Anchorage Museum Association and served on its board from 1969 to 1985, and was also a founding member of the Visual Arts Center of Alaska, originally known as the Experimental Arts and Crafts Center. In 2004 she received an Anchorage Mayor's Award for the Arts for Lifetime Achievement.

She was married twice. From 1969 to 1983 she was married to Robert Allen Frederick, a professor of history at AMU, and seven years later she married John R. Van de Water with whom she lived until his death in 2001.

Saradell Ard died December 18, 2009 in Anchorage at the age of 89.

Scope and Content Description:

The bulk of this collection pertains to Ard's manuscript of *Eskimo Art: A Circumpolar History*, including documents, correspondence, permissions, slides, photographs, drawings, manuscript drafts and edits, and captions. Other prominent series are research publications (other scholars' works) and Ard's notes on various research topics. The majority of the items are professional in nature, though there are some personal notes and items as well. While most of the materials date from the late 1970s through the 1980s, there are some documents and photos from Saradell's college days, as well as, her time in the army. The collection holds a total of 5874 images, with Correspondence – Permissions having 31, Personal Papers having 22, Research – Topics having 10, Research Notes having 1, Dissertations having 9, Manuscript having 7, Visual Materials having 5663, and Army Crafts having 131.

The scrapbook from the series Army Crafts identified several people stationed at Fort Jay in New York, including: Barbara Carpenter, Mildred Cribby, Lt. Donald Gluck, Anthony Lenzo, Philip Palmer, and Colonel John S. Roosma.

Contents remain in the order in which they arrived. Newly created folders were interfiled among existing folders. Some items were separated from their original placement and placed in another series. Notes were written on the folder itself to indicate this. Research publications were reorganized and alphabetized by the lead author's last name. Art Organization Publications were pulled from their original folders and were placed together in a new series. Many slides were originally placed in plastic sleeves. Those were removed and re-housed in archival boxes. The order in which they were originally organized was kept.

Technical Access: No special equipment is needed to access the materials.

ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

Acquisition and Appraisal Information:

This collection was donated by the Ard estate in May 2011.

Processing Notes:

This collection was originally processed by Janet R. Klein in 2010. Additional processing was undertaken by Claire Agni in June-July 2013. Duplicate items, be they photocopies of documents (especially correspondence and captions), or photographs or slides were removed from the collection. Categories for the slides and photographs sometimes repeated; duplicates were normally not checked for in that circumstance. Plastic bindings were removed from the scrapbook and two photo books in Series 14. Also, photographs in the scrapbook were attached

to the original pages using archival photo corners. Folder and box numbers on the folders themselves may not be accurate. Please refer to the Finding Aid for correct placement and order. Staples, metal paperclips and rubber bands were removed and replaced with archival paperclips. Some folders were combined when materials were similar (such as correspondence date range), or there were only one or two items in the folder. Information in brackets [] was provided by the processor (Klein) to identify an object or culture, e.g. OBS [Old Bering Sea] and Arctic Small Tool [tradition], expand on a person's name, e.g. Abramova, [Z.A.], explain abbreviations such as Canadian Coops. [Co-operative Associations], and offer an alternative spelling such as Pentatac [Penatac]. Materials disposed of from the collection include medical information about S. Ard and/or her husband, and papers written by her college students, their Social Security Numbers, and their grades. Dates listed are the earliest and/or last found printed on the materials. If the dates are within brackets [], the dates are approximate, or were found handwritten on a document.

Separated Materials:

The Resource Center kept 27 books, 25 periodicals, three museum exhibit catalogs, one thesis, and one auction catalog. Pages marked by S. Ard were left as marked. Many other books were returned to the executor as they duplicated holdings. [Small brochures and catalogs also exist in numerous folders.]

RELATED MATERIALS

Related materials exist in the Anchorage Museum. In 2010, the Saradell Ard Collection consisted of 11 paintings by her. She also donated artwork created by other artists to the museum.
