The AHFAM Collection consists of 46 photographs and 7 negatives of Native Alaskan Peoples and related scenes. The photographs range in date from the 1880's to 1930. Photographs in the collection include photos of Native burial Ceremonies, Chief Johnson's, Chief Kyan's, and Chief Kadashan's totem poles, Kasaan totems, Tlingit Natives, Auk Village, Kootznahoo, Killisnoo Jake, Native dancers, and several potlatches.
