

**WORKLAN COLLECTION. Photos. .33 cu. ft. 1926 - 1928**

Anton and Hector Worklan worked on the Richardson Highway from 1927 to 1928. According to their family, they worked on the Alaska Railroad from Fairbanks to Seward. However, photographs in the collection indicate otherwise.

This collection consists of 235 black and white photographs housed in three albums. Photograph subjects include Washington State, the Richardson Highway, Alaska Road Commission crews and projects, Fairbanks, the Ester Mine, and the Chena River. The album pages have photo descriptions; however, the print is faded and difficult to read.

This collection was donated to the Anchorage Museum by Irene and Robert Worklan in 1975. The images were catalogued in April 1982 by Archives volunteer Jean Ray.
