The Alaska Historical Society Collection is a set of prints taken from a set of glass plate negatives donated by Robertson Collins to the Society. The negatives are deposited at UAF and a similar set of prints exist at the Alaska State Library in Juneau.

The Alaska Historical Society Collection consists of 141 photographs. The photographs are black and white and were taken along the Yukon River around 1900. The subjects include schoolchildren, local residents of Koyuk, the Meyers themselves, and landscapes and consist of Alaska Natives, gold dredges, log cabins, and river and scenic views.

This collection was donated to the Anchorage Museum by the Alaska Historical Society in 1976.
