- .1 – Oil discovery camp, #1 oil camp for ARCO, Prudhoe Bay 1968 Feb.-Mar. Loydd [sic] Madson, Frank Love in charge of camp. I was a mess cook for U.S.I. Inc. [trailer buildings, parked trucks and equipment]
- .2 – ARCO! 1st camp on North Slope, PUO, Alaska 1968 Feb.-Mar. Jet rangers: caution! Do not start at temp's exceeding -35°F [helicopter]
- .3 – ARCO! Prudhoe Bay 1968 Feb-Mar [twin prop airplane next to pile of supplies, tent structure and small building on skis in background]
- .4 – A covered snow-machine!!! ARCO, PUO Bay 1968, Feb-Mar. [enclosed snowmachine in camp yard]
- .5 – Goose Widgeon, Jim Osborne, wx observer, Cordova, AK, pilot. Weather shack, ARCO Prudhoe Bay, 1968 Feb-Mar. [weather station]
- .6 – ARCO! PUO Bay 1968 Feb-Mar [prop airplane at sunrise or sunset]
- .7 – Looking south, ARCO! PUO Bay 1968 Feb. [sunrise or sunset, person walking and buildings in distance]
