Administrative/Biographical History:

Samuel Luther Hogue was born February 24, 1868 in Lamar, Texas, to Samuel Newton Hogue and Elizabeth Susan Tull Hogue. He lived in Petersburg and co-owned Hogue & Tveten. The *Index to Dawson City, Yukon Territory and Alaska directory and gazetteer, Alaska-Yukon directory and gazetteer, and Polk's Alaska-Yukon gazetteer and business directory, 1901-1912* lists Hogue as a miner in Dawson City in 1901 and in Nome in 1901-1902, and as a general merchandiser in Petersburg starting in 1909. Hogue died on June 10, 1923, and was buried in Wrangell.

Additional genealogical information about the Hogue and Cornelius families is available in the accession file.
