Nothing was known about W.T. Roberts when this Finding Aid was written.

Scope and Content Description:

The leather-bound scrapbook album documents steamship and railroad journeys in Southeast and Southcentral Alaska dated between 1926-1928. The album contains 472 items, including black-and-white photographic prints interspersed with commercially produced postcards, art prints, and tourism ephemera such as dining tickets, menus, souvenir booklets, etc. Areas of Alaska shown include Anchorage, Chenega, Chitina, Cordova, Gulkana, Haines, Juneau, Kasaan, Ketchikan, Latouche, Petersburg, Seward, Sitka, Valdez, and Wrangell.
