**Administrative/Biographical History:**

Michael Barron (1947-2016) owned and operated both Snowbird Photography and Maiden Alaska Photography. He was raised on a homestead in the Big Lake area, and subsequently homesteaded on the Tokositna River in what later became Denali National Park. He also operated Barony Lodge on the west side of Cook Inlet.

**Scope and Content Description:**

The collection consists of examples of the commercial work of Michael Barron, including negatives, prints, 35mm slides, medium format transparencies and publications. Images are in color unless otherwise noted. Images include artistic nudes from Maiden Alaska as well as scenic and wildlife shots from Snowbird Photography.
