Administrative/Biographical History:

Ken L. Parker was an amateur photographer in the Spenard area. He and his wife, Nancy Smallwood Parker, arrived in Alaska in 1946 and lived in a one-bedroom home on Fireweed Lane in Spenard. The original home lot is now part of the land underneath North Star Elementary School. Ken Parker worked on the Alaska Railroad for the first year.

In 1947, Ken Parker and his wife moved to Spenard and Fireweed Lane. They bought a Quonset hut from the Army Surplus in Seward and had it shipped by train to Anchorage. The Quonset hut became the first Parker's Store, which was the first department store in Spenard and was also the Post Office. For a time, it was the only non-grocery store in Spenard. Nancy Parker worked as Postmaster in 1947 and then again in 1950. Ken worked as a volunteer fireman and was the Director of Spenard Public Utility District for an unknown amount of time. In 1955, Nancy was elected president of the Anchorage Parent Teacher Association. In 1964, Ken worked for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) at the Hill Building in downtown Anchorage. The family store was not damaged in the 1964 Earthquake. The Parker's store was eventually moved to a new location at the Aurora Village Automobiler's.

Scope and Content Description:

This collection consists of 30 photographs, 870 photo slides, and one piece of ephemera depicting significant events and places primarily in the greater Anchorage area in the 1950s-1980s. There are many photographs of the aftermath of the 1964 Earthquake in Anchorage, dog sledding, outdoor recreation, and fishing. There are also a significant number of photographs of Anchorage neighborhoods and roads in the 1950s-1970s. There are a significant number of photographs from Romig Hill and Spenard Road. There are also photographs of Alaska Day Celebrations, including a parade highlighting the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI), Fur Rendezvous Celebrations, and the fight for and celebration of Alaskan Statehood.

Arrangement: Original order largely maintained, loosely arranged by subject.
