Vowels

- a Chin'an like a in English "father" or sometimes like "cat" (Upper Inlet dialect)
- **e Yagheli** an "uh" sound like English a in "about" or sometimes like "elbow" (Upper Inlet dialect)
- **i Kił** like i in English "sit" or "magazine", can sound closer to English e when next to a back velar like in łiq'a
- **U USh** like u in English "dude", can sound like o next to a back velar like in gguya

Terms Labial

Sounds made with the lips

Dental

Sounds made with the tongue and the teeth

Alveolar

Sounds made by touching the tooth sockets **Lateral**

Sounds that make airflow from the sides of the tongue

Palatal

Sounds made by touching the middle of the roof of the mouth **Front Velar**

Sounds made by touching the soft part of the roof of the mouth **Back Velar**

Sounds made by touching the uvula or near it

Glottal

Consonant sounds made from the vocal cords
