# Administrative/Biographical History:

On September 14, 1930, Helen L. Roberts (b. 1902, d. 1999) married Marden K. Stiffler (b. 1903, d. 1990) in Cook, Illinois<sup>1</sup>. In the 1930s, the couple taught for 10 years in Flat and Chignik, Alaska. In the late 1930s or early 1940s, Helen and Marden had a daughter, Carole Stiffler. Not much was known about Helen and Marden Stiffler when this Finding Aid was written.

### Scope and Content Description:

Collection is comprised of one leatherbound photo album containing 61 black-and-white photographic prints that were hand-tinted by Helen L. Stiffler. This album was given to Helen and Marden from their students in Flat, dated 1937-1938. Subjects include canneries, sled dogs, snowshoeing, glaciers and travel by boat and plane. The areas depicted include Flat, Seward, and Southeast Alaska.

Arrangement: Original order maintained.
