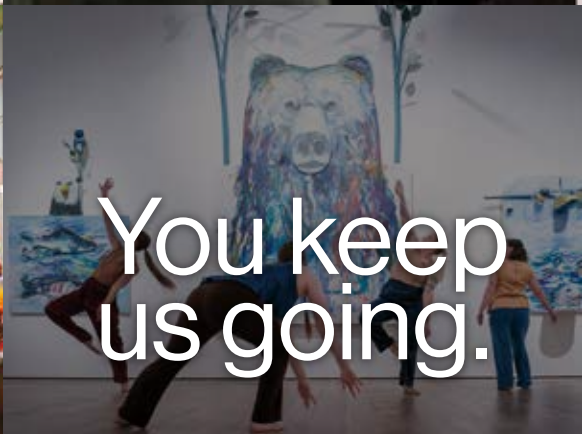


GRATITUDE REPORT




Our Mission
