Administrative/Biographical History:

The following biographical information is from the Dictionary of Canadian Biography:

Jules Jetté (b. 30 Sept.,1864, d. 4 Feb. 1927) was a professor, Jesuit missionary, ethnographer, and specialist in the Koyukon language. He was born in Akulurak, Alaska, and attended Petit Séminaire de Montréal from 1874 to 1880. In 1882 he entered the Society of Jesus. After, he began his novitiate and finished in September 1884 after taking his final vows. Jetté then pursued intellectual studies in the natural sciences, numerous languages (Latin, Greek, Italian, Spanish, English), and French literature, which he completed in 1898.

Around 1890, Jetté was sent to teach mathematics and science in Manitoba until 1892. It was during these years he began his pursuit of a missionary vocation. In 1896 Jetté was ordained to the priesthood, and in 1898 Rome granted his request to be sent to Alaska as a missionary. Father Jetté's work in Alaska spanned 1898 to 1927, with a brief time spent in Canada and Washington.

In 1898 Father Jetté arrived at Holy Cross and soon departed for St. Michael Mission where he spent three months. Afterwards, he travelled north to Nulato where he began his pastoral

rounds along the Yukon River and into the interior. During his early missionary work he learned Koyukon and would eventually publish prayers, songs, and devotions in the Indigenous language. He also authored a dictionary which remained unpublished until 2000.

In 1904, Jetté returned to Nulato and went on to Fairbanks the following year. From 1907 to 1913, he worked in Kokrines and the surrounding areas, before going back to Nulato. Between 1914 to 1922 he lived in the Tanana region, and in 1916 he spent a little time doing substitute work in Ruby and Kokrines. Due to health problems beginning in 1922, he left Alaska and didn't return until 1925. Father Jetté resumed work in Fairbanks but moved to Holy Cross in 1926 where he died a year later.¹

Scope and Content Description:

Collection contains 309 5x7 nitrate negatives and original neg books with descriptions. Images depict people and places along the Yukon River, primarily between Ruby to Tanana.

Arrangement: Original order maintained.

Physical Access: Nitrate negatives in freezer. Materials are digitized and viewable online. Access copies available on-site for research.
