Using this Guide

The materials in this subject guide were compiled and shared by Alice Sullivan in 2024 and 2025. The project titled, “Anchorage Dance History: Connecting Generations,” honors individuals who made a significant contribution to studio dance in Anchorage and Southcentral Alaska from the 1950s to present. Artists were asked to submit a biography along with 1-10 images and related materials with descriptions that represent the artists and career highlights.

The artists are organized by Generations. Generation I is comprised of artists who started dance studios, schools, and companies to teach and perform foundational and classical forms of dance, such as ballet, modern, jazz, and tap, at a time of rapid growth and community development in the Southcentral region during the 1950s to 1960s. Generation II represents artist connected to or taught by Generation I that continued the growth of their programs, or started new ones between the 1970s and 1980s. Generation III represents the continued growth and connection of the studio dance community in Anchorage and the surrounding area from the 1980s to present day.
